# Kinship Caregiver Support Program

Have you taken on the responsibility of raising your grandchild or other relative child?

Do you feel you can't continue caring for this child unless you get some help?



## **HELP IS AVAILABLE!**

Assistance for an individual caregiver will be limited to once per year and a maximum of \$500.

Exceptions may be granted based on local program administrative review and on a case-by-case need basis, but in no event will individual goods and services assistance to any caregiver exceed \$1000 in any 12-month period.

Will assistance with these things help make a difference in the life of the child you're caring for?

- ▶ First/Last month's rent
- ▶ Utility Hook-ups
- ▶ One-Time rent or utility assistance
- ▶ Purchase of bedding, furniture, clothes, supplies
- ▶ Gas and bus vouchers
- ▶ Car Repairs
- ▶ Transition Counseling to adjust to the new living arrangement
- ▶ School Supplies/ Uniforms/ Field trips/ Youth Activities
- ▶ Band instrument rentals
- ▶ Durable Medical Equipment
- ▶ Medications for the child
