

2022 Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP)

Aging & Adult Care of Central Washington will distribute vouchers to qualified seniors who reside in Adams, Chelan, Douglas, Grant, Lincoln, and Okanogan counties on a first come, first serve basis.

Qualifications:

To be eligible for the SFMNP, you must meet all of the following:

You must be 60 years old or older (or 55+ if you are Native American /Alaska Native)

Your income must be below 185% of Federal Poverty Level and you must be a resident of Washington State:

- \$25,142 Annual or \$2,096 Monthly Income for 1 person
- \$33,874 Annual or \$2,823 Monthly Income for 2 people
- o For larger households, add \$728 for each additional person

Using your Farmers Market checks:

- SFMNP participants can use their checks to buy approved products. These include fresh fruits, fresh vegetables, fresh cut herbs, and honey at approved Farmers Markets & Farm Stores in Washington State.
- You can use cash along with the vouchers; however, no change will be given back with your purchase.
- If you lose your vouchers or if they are stolen; we cannot replace them. Please inform AACCW at the number above if this happens.
- You must use your checks between June 1 and October 31.
